(MSR Minimum 4 parts each tune) **(Own Choice)**

Event P4&D4 Open

Section 1. MSR (Own Choice)

(4 parts minimum each tune required)

Section 2. Hornpipe & Jig (Own Choice)

(1x4 parted Hornpipe & 1x4 parted Jig or 1x4 parted Hornpipe & 2x2 parted Jigs)

Event P5 Open Piobaireachd (Submit 3 Piobaireachd)

A,B&C Grade 18 Years and Over Permitted to play in this event

Competitors Entering Events P4&D4 MUST play in both sections

Drummers must start with two 3 paced rolls

Piping events P1&P2 1 min 30 seconds for tuning on stage

Piping events P3&P4 3 mins for tuning on stage
